



Parent Comments

Parents' evening needs work. One teacher didn't turn up. Too many subjects we couldn't get an appointment for and despite asking for a phone call we are still waiting!

I was unable to get online to attend my parents' evening appointments. I sent messages to a number of X's teachers with whom I was unable to obtain an appointment. Mr xxxx has called me and updated me on Xs progress. I therefore can only comment on her progress in English. I have therefore answered the questions for the other subjects as subject not studied so that I can submit the survey.

Found 5 minute cut off for parents' evening rather abrupt - some queries left unanswered. Please ensure toilets are clean and safe for children, with doors that lock. If vandalised by unruly pupils, don't think other children should suffer.

I found the parents' evening useful and informative with the teachers that we met. I haven't been able to comment on some of the subjects as we didn't have opportunity to meet the teachers and have had no feedback on progress or activities e.g. drama, dance. The 1:1 communication with parents could be much improved when contacting the school with a query or concern. I've been surprised about the lack of pastoral support offered by the school, particularly during such a difficult time for children. I have concerns about how non academic needs are addressed within school and hope that this is improved as the Covid measures are reduced. Some aspects of this school are excellent and unfortunately the poorer response on the non academic side lets the whole experience down.

Overall I was very happy with the virtual parents' evening, although I had no response from X's dance and food teachers. I was also unable to get an appointment with her English teacher and I know we got an email to say if there was anything to report they would get in touch but i would have preferred to actually speak so I could ask any questions. Overall very pleased with X's progress so far at SAX, thank you.

It's hard to comment on progress in RE as I was unable to make an appointment with the teacher, also dance and drama teacher wasn't there/had a technical issue for the appointment made so we were unable to meet. The school have supported my child well during these very challenging times but look forward to more normality and the opportunities that this will bring.

We had an appointment with Mrs Brook and she did not turn up. No apologies given.

South Axholme Academy response: Many thanks for your feedback. Teachers pay and conditions indicate one Parents' Evening per academic year. For additional updates please contact your child's individual teacher. We have appointed an additional Progress and Achievement Leader for Year 9, and as such this should alleviate the amount of responses made - similarly, please contact your child's form tutor for any pastoral matters.

Access to online learning during periods of self isolation needs to be improved as some lessons are inactive or difficult to follow. I would like to see a much more varied and regular activity program at school to enrich and engage pupils. Career's advice seems a little pressured in year 7. I would like more information about the situation with masks in school after then 17th of May please.

South Axholme Academy response: Many thanks for your feedback. We appreciate the help and support from parents whilst we continue with the blended learning approach. It would be hoped that once restrictions lift, we can return to a more normal program of activities. We continue to provide regular updates, and letters are posted on our website for full information.
