The Department for Education (DfE) provided additional funding for all students in Year 7 from 2012 onwards, who achieved below their age-related expectations at the end of KS2. This additional funding is to be used by schools/academies to provide literacy and numeracy catch-up support for Year 7 students. It is designed to help students catch up as quickly as possible. #### Numeracy:

The students follow a bespoke maths programme to boost their confidence and build skills in Mathematics to support the KS<sub>3</sub> curriculum.

#### Literacy:

The students follow a personalised literacy programme, targeting Reading and Writing. They have access to specialised materials and are taught by dedicated specialist staff.
