

CODE OF CONDUCT(summary)

A high standard of behaviour and self-discipline is required from all students. You are expected to show courtesy and respect to staff, visitors and to one another.

Always pay careful attention during lessons and do not talk whilst others are talking. You should never disturb other students and stop them from working. You should move about the school in a quiet and orderly manner. Always keep to the left and do not run. Anti-social behaviour such as swearing, teasing and bullying will not be tolerated at this school. Remember that our school is judged by your appearance and behaviour both in school and on the way to and from school. Please take a pride in your personal appearance, your work and the place where we all spend our working day.

Bullying

Bullying may be verbal or physical and will not be tolerated by the school in any form whatsoever. If you are a victim of bullying, or if you observe incidents involving others, do not hesitate to inform a member of staff. You should not put up with bullies in your group of friends.

ILLNESS, ACCIDENTS AND TRANSPORT

Illness and Accidents - If you feel unwell or have an accident you should tell a teacher straight away. The teacher will give you a note and send you to Student Services. If you are too ill to remain at school or if hospital treatment is necessary then your parents will be contacted. Medicines If you need to take medicine at school you should bring a letter from your parents stating when you need to take it. Your medicine must be left atStudent Services. The only exception is if you have an inhaler for asthma, which you should keep yourself.

Transport

Most students travel to school by bus. There are very clear rules about behaviour on buses and these are issued with each bus pass and displayed in each form room. These rules must be adhered to as failure to do so could result in your bus pass being withdrawn.
