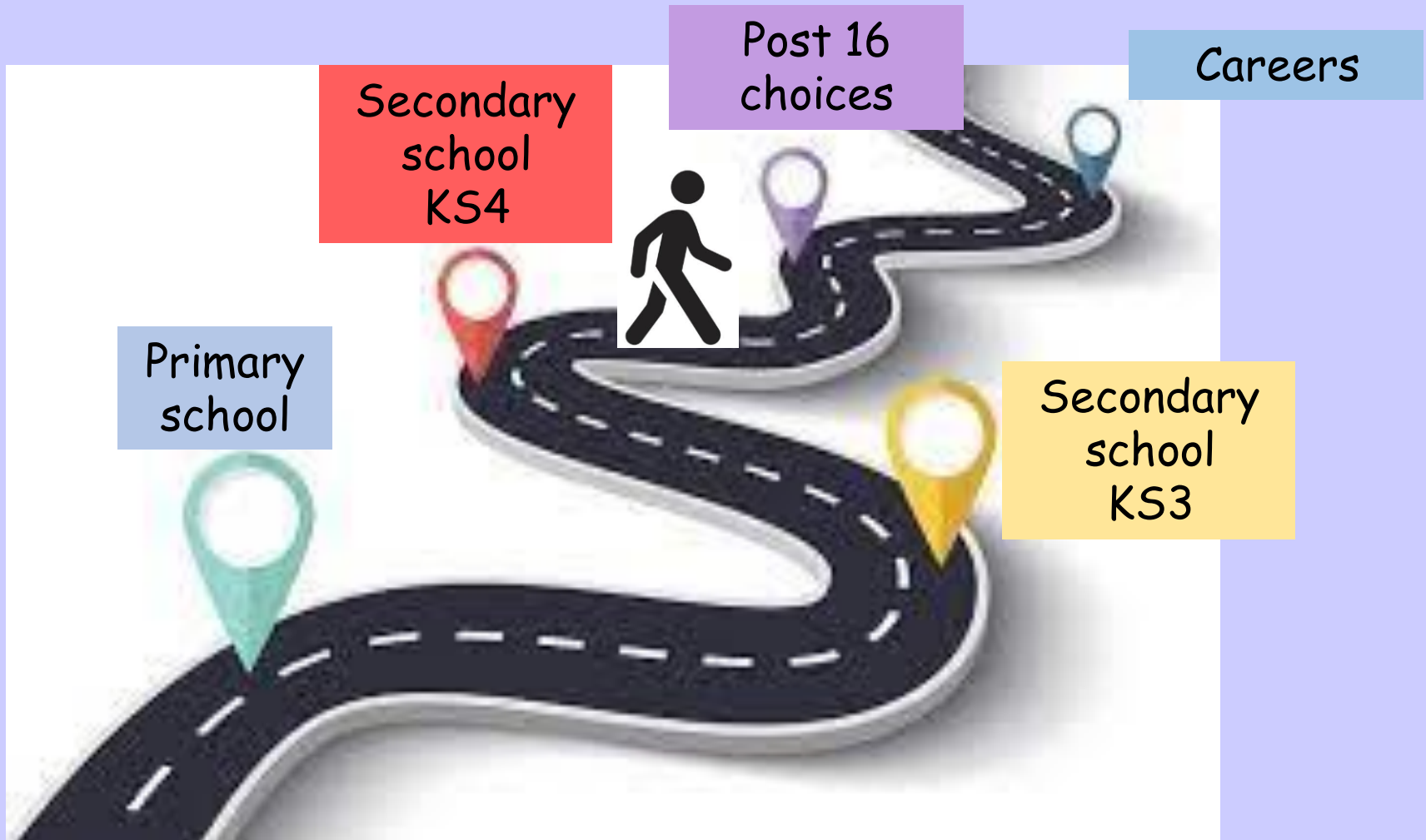

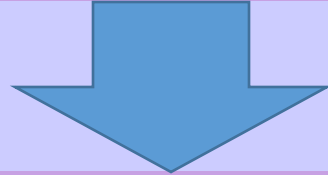

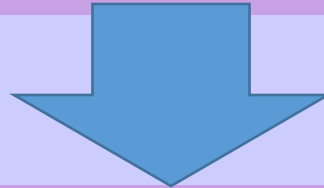
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Yearly Whole School Assessment Schedule

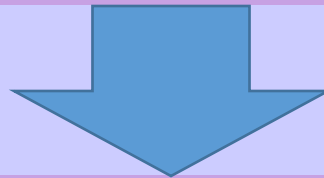

End of Year Assessments

Friday 23rd June 2023 – Wednesday 5th July 2023

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Develop revision strategies for an exam, to be given the opportunity to **show what you can do** in an exam and to give themselves and their teachers the **opportunity to reflect on the assessments and put specific intervention in place.**
