What happens if I do not have the correct uniform?

If the correct uniform is not worn in school, then you will remain in your supervised room completing your lessons until you are able to wear the correct uniform.


We aim to support all member of the school community, and if the incorrect uniform is due to financial issues please speak to your PAL or Mrs Bullars and/or ask home to contact school.



School Equipment












Don't forget that you can buy equipment from the school shop before school and each break.

What happens if I don't have the correct equipment?

You can buy equipment each morning and each break time at the school shop.

Your form tutor will check your equipment each morning. If you forget your equipment once then this will be noted and you will be leant equipment.

If you forget more than once behaviour points will be given.





Prohibited Items - reminder

- Jewellery and all piercings

- Chewing gum

- Fireworks
- Smart Watches
- Alcohol
- Illegal substances
- Any kind of weapon, real or imitation
- The Academy accepts no liability or responsibility for these items if students decide to bring them on to the premises.
- In addition, the academy may make the decision that if a student has previously been caught with such items a detention or other suitable sanction may be imposed.

Mobile Phones



- Mobile phones may only be brought onto the premises if they are switched off and kept out of sight.
- They may not be used for any reason on the premises, or on trips or at sports fixtures organised off the premises, unless the student has the express permission of a member of staff.
- The academy will not accept liability for the theft, damage or loss of a mobile phone and students must accept full responsibility for it at all times.
- If a student is seen with their mobile phone (not necessarily using it) the phone will be confiscated until the end of the day. If a student repeatedly commits this breach of code, further sanctions will be put in place.
- If a student needs to make a phone call during the day, they should approach student reception.
- If you need to contact your child, this must be done via student reception




Start of the day Arriving at school
