7	Religious Cultures	<p>Students will over the course of the day will</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • visit Doncaster Minster • visit Sri Guru Kalgidhar Gurdwara • explore the importance of each building and its importance to religious believers, • learn about each religion and receive a talk from the priest and Imam where they will be able to ask questions to further their awareness and understanding of religious ideas.
8	STEM (Cross Curricular)	<p>Students will over the course of the day take part in sessions to</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • give them an awareness of STEM all around them and how it can impact their lives • provide them with the opportunity to build and test various structures and designs
9	Crime and Safety Awareness	<p>Students will over the course of the day take part in sessions to</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • recognise online and offline risks to their wellbeing • encourage responsible, respectful and active citizens who are able to play their part and become actively involved in public life as adults • Sessions will be delivered by several external providers.

10	Careers	<p>Students will over the course of the day take part in sessions to</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • further help them manage their careers, sustain employment and achieve personal and economic wellbeing throughout their lives. • help students be Ready, Resilient, Respectful in their future career journeys. • One session during the day will be a careers fair with further education providers, higher education providers and employers all invited. • Students will take part in a 1-1 mock interview with an external employer.
11	Preparing for Exams	<p>Students will over the course of the day take part in sessions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • focussed on non-calculator skills in preparation for the first Mathematics exam on 15th May. • to recap and revise the Science paper 1 Required Practical tasks. • to improve exam technique when answering extended answer questions in Science examination papers. • are bespoke to meet individual needs in English and close gaps to prepare them for their upcoming examinations.
