** Maths and English will alternate between bands on a weekly basis. Week 1 A band students will be with English while B band students will be with Maths. This will be communicated weekly to students.*

Year 11 Scan 3 Data – W/c Monday 30 March 2026

During the week commencing Monday 30 March 2026, Year 11 students and parents/carers will receive their Scan 3 data. Like with previous scans, students will receive a target grade and an expected grade as well as their Mock 2 grades.

Target Grades show the grades that we expect your child to achieve at the end of Year 11. This Target Grade is generated using the information from assessments we completed at the start of Year 7, with the students and comparing them with the historic performance of students of a similar ability nationally at the end of Key Stage 4.

You will also find an Expected Grade which indicates the grade, at the present time, we feel that your child is on track to achieve by the end of Year 11.

This grade is generated by subject teachers and considers a variety of factors including classwork, coursework, independent learning (homework tasks), assessment data and mock examination data.

Mock 2 grades reflect the grade scored in the recent mock examination sessions.

Students were also provided with an Attitude to Learning (AtL) for each subject and received either Outstanding, Good, Coasting or Cause for Concern.

Easter Holiday Revision Sessions

We have already shared with students and yourselves the Easter revision sessions, that staff will be running over the holidays. These sessions are open to all students, and the schedule is attached to this letter.

Please could we ask that you support us and your child, by encouraging their attendance at the extra Easter sessions, as I am sure you will agree this is an excellent opportunity for all students.

Summer Examination Series

The summer examination series starts on **Friday 8 May 2026**.

Please see attached a copy of the general timetable (in the guide to GCSE preparation booklet) that has previously been shared with students and parents.

Please note that all students must be available to sit an examination on **Wednesday 24 June 2026** as this is a contingency day set by the examination boards.

Students will be attending school as normal during the summer examination period and will be attending their normal scheduled lessons or a pre-examination class when not in an examination.

Full attendance throughout the examination period is vital if students are to perform at their best.

Final Date Required in the Academy

On Monday 15 June 2026 there are two examinations – Physics / Combined Science Physics and Further Maths. One or both of these examinations will require the majority of the year group. After this date, other than the celebration event mentioned below, students are only required to attend the academy for the examinations and masterclasses that week, namely GCSE Spanish Reading on Tuesday 16 June 2026 - AM session, and on Wednesday 17 June - AM session GCSE Spanish – Writing examination.

GCSE Spanish Reading – Tuesday 16 June 2026 and GCSE Spanish Writing – Wednesday 17 June 2026.

Students who are sitting their GCSE Spanish Reading and Writing examination should attend the academy on the morning of Tuesday 16 June 2026 and Wednesday 17 June 2026, as normal and as soon as the examination has finished, they should arrange to be collected and sign out of the academy.

Year 11 Celebration Event - Thursday 18 June 2026, Leavers Morning Assembly

We would like to invite all students to the academy on Thursday 18 June 2026, to celebrate their time at South Axholme Academy.

Students should arrive at the academy as normal (they may use academy transport) at the start of the academy day to meet their form tutors in the dining hall. They will have the opportunity for students and staff to sign their shirts in the dining hall and on the academy playground.

Students will stay with us until 10.30am. Please note that academy transport will not be available at this time, therefore please ensure that they are collected from the academy between 10.30am - 10.45am.

During the celebration event, students will have the chance to have their shirts signed and take friendship and group photographs.

The celebration event will include a special assembly which will reflect on their time at the academy. There will also be a presentation of some special awards!

We would love it if every student were able to attend the event as we know from previous years that this is a brilliant and emotional event!

Year 11 Examination Results

Students can collect their examination results on **Thursday 20 August 2026 from 9.00am until 11.00am.** If you are collecting on behalf of your child, you will need a signed letter/email from **them** giving permission for you to pick them up, and the nominated person should bring photograph ID with them.

Students will have the option to have their examination results electronically sent to them via the education record England app (apple and android). During the next mindset day (30 April) students will have the opportunity to register with the app and receive approval via staff in school. Prior to this, it would be useful for those students to download the app.
