Dear Parents/Carers,

Leaving Arrangements

As we approach the end of the GCSE exam period, some exams fall on days when students may finish at lunchtime. We therefore ask parents to confirm whether they give permission for their child to leave the academy at this earlier time. Please note that if permission is not received, your child will be required to remain in school as normal. To provide consent, please complete the Microsoft Form included at the end of this letter.

Dates that students may leave early:

Friday 12 June 2026

There will be a Physics masterclass until 12:30pm. Students may leave after this time, provided appropriate permission has been given.

Monday 15 June 2026

Science examinations will finish at varying times throughout the morning, depending on individual entries. Students may leave once their exams are completed. This does not apply to students taking Further Maths, who are required to attend a masterclass and their afternoon examination.

After 15 June 2026

From this date onwards, students are only required to attend specific Spanish examinations and associated masterclasses, as outlined below:

- **Spanish Reading:** Tuesday 16 June 2026 (morning)
- **Spanish Writing:** Wednesday 17 June 2026 (morning)

Students should leave the academy once they have completed their examination and have been signed out in the usual manner.

Year 11 Celebration Event - Thursday 18 June 2026, Leavers Morning Assembly

We would like to remind you that students will be able to attend the academy on Thursday 18 June 2026, to celebrate their time at South Axholme Academy.

Arrival: Students should arrive at the academy as normal (they may use academy transport) at the start of the academy day to meet their form tutors in the dining hall.

What should I do if I can't collect my results?

If you are unable to collect your results in person students can email the Exams Officer at datateam@southaxholme-iet.co.uk, from their school email account by midday on Friday 17 July, with their name, contact number and the name of the family member who they wish to nominate to collect on their behalf. On Results day, the nominated person must also bring photographic proof of their identity, in the form of a driver's licence or passport.

The results belong to the student and to protect their confidentiality, we will be unable to release results without such consent and evidence.

Any results not collected will be emailed to student's school email addresses after 1pm. Collected in person or by a nominated adult with permission. Results can also be received via the **Education Record England app** if a student signed up to this during the last Mindset Day.
